HEALTH REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

Prior to boarding your dog, we need to make sure that he/she is healthy, current on all vaccinations, flea & tick control and that his/her annual fecal test are up to date.

Please have your vet hospital email a copy of your dogs vaccination records and the original IDEXX fecal test results document to the Tappen Hill office prior to your evaluation appointment or prior to your dog's boarding stay.

VACCINATIONS:

- 1) Bordetella 2) Distemper Combination w/ Lepto
- 3) Rabies 4) Canine Influenza H3N8 & H3N2

FECAL TESTS:

We require the fecal test to be performed through IDEXX Labs:

- COMPREHENSIVE ANTIGEN PANEL + GIARDIA
- Ova & Parasite Float

(IDEXX has a single order code for combining both tests: order code 24639)

CURRENT FLEA CONTROL:

As recommended by your veterinarian

Vaccination Note: We require that the above vaccinations be "current", as defined by your veterinarian. When vaccination titers are medically necessary (in lieu of vaccinating), we require a letter from your vet indicating that your dog has adequate immunity and listing the future date when the titer is scheduled to be repeated. We use that date as the titer's expiration date in our records.

Flea Control Note: Any type of flea control that is recommended by your vet is acceptable to us providing it is current and effective. At Tappen Hill, dogs arriving with fleas or ticks will not (of course) be socialized or grouped with other dogs until they are flea and tick free. Therefore, if your dog arrives with fleas and/or ticks, there may be an additional charge for a private run until treatment for the parasites is successful. There may also be an extra charge for a flea/tick bath. In addition (for fleas), there may be an extra charge for a single dose of oral flea product as currently recommended by our vet. Prior to administering the flea/tick bath and/or an oral flea product, we will call you and/or your vet for approval.
